2020 Seafood TRADE Relief PROGRAM (STRP) In Alaska State and Federally Managed Fisheries



Seafood Trade Relief Program

- **The Seafood Trade Relief Assistance Program (STRP)** provides direct payments to eligible commercial fishermen impacted by trade tariffs.
- **SIGNUP Period** - SEPT 14, 2020 to DEC 14, 2020
- Applicants can submit a **CCC-916 STRP** application to any county FSA office
 - Application will be processed and paid by the administrative county office in which the applicant resides.

Atka Mackerel	\$0.10
Crab – Dungeness, King, Snow (Opilio Tanner), Southern (Bairdi) Tanner	\$0.47
Flounder	\$0.15
Geoduck	\$0.76
Goosefish (not in Alaska)	\$0.10
Herrings (Roe, Bait, Spawn)	\$0.04
Lobster (not in Alaska)	\$0.50
Pacific Cod (Cod or P-Cod)	\$0.14

Pacific Ocean Perch	\$0.10
Pollock	\$0.10
Sablefish (Blackcod)	\$0.10
Salmon (All five species)	\$0.16
Sole	\$0.15
Squid	\$0.20
Tunas (not in Alaska)	\$0.13
Turbot (Greenland Halibut) (NOT Pacific Halibut)	\$0.15

Who is eligible to apply?

- Commercial fishermen who are in business at the time of application
- Fishermen with a federal or state license or permit to commercially catch and sell/transfer fish
- Fishermen who have **ownership** interest in seafood production (landings) reported as U.S. caught and sold in calendar year 2019.
